Getting started with Aula

A secure platform

Aula is a secure platform where data is stored and processed safely. You and your children's data will not be used for commercial purposes.

You can access Aula with your UNI login. The parts of Aula containing sensitive personal information must be accessed via NemID or through an app which requires a PIN or fingerprint to log in.

When can you use Aula?

Aula will be rolled out in Danish schools and after school centres after the 2019 summer holidays. From 2020, Aula will also cover day care institutions in 95 of Denmark's municipalities.

What is Aula?

Aula will be the future communication platform in schools, after school centres and day care institutions. In Aula you get secure and user-friendly access to information and dialogue between school, day care and home.

Following your child from day care to Year 10

Aula makes it easy to keep track of your child's daily life and development. When nursery and kindergarten give way to a place at school and in the after school centre, or if your child changes school, Aula moves with them as a communication platform.

Aula is built in such a way that the features help your children to gradually take over in the dialogue with the school as they get older and acquire more digital skills.

How to use Aula

You only need to log in to one place when you want to communicate with school, teachers, educators and other parents.

Aula offers a variety of features such as a messaging feature, a bulletin board with important information and a calendar. It is also possible to share photos and videos in Aula, so you can be involved in the children's daily life.

You choose how often and what you want to be notified about.
